5 key aspects to consider when choosing your child's school:



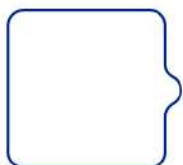
EDUCATIONAL APPROACH

Does the school's teaching model suit the way your child learns? Look into whether they use project-based learning or active methodologies such as Montessori or HighScope.



EMOTIONAL AND SOCIAL ENVIRONMENT

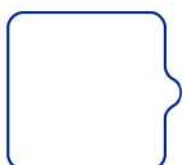
Beyond the curriculum: how does a child feel at school? Notice whether they are listened to, respected, and valued in their daily life.



FACILITIES AND SAFETY

Is the environment safe, welcoming, and designed to support your child's development?

Pay attention to details such as proper lighting, thorough staff vetting processes, and a dedicated team responsible for maintaining clean and well-kept facilities.



COMMUNICATION WITH FAMILIES

The relationship between the school and your family matters. Assess whether there are open, trustworthy communication channels and consistent support.



INITIAL ADAPTATION AND SUPPORT

The early days make a real difference. Find out how the school helps your child settle in calmly and confidently, without anxiety.
